YOUR LEGAL DUTY: WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU'RE NOT PUWER COMPLIANT?

Under PUWER (Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998)

EMPLOYERS MUST ENSURE

- Equipment is risk-assessed:
 Identify and control potential hazards before use.
- Operators are trained and competent:
 Only trained staff should use machinery or equipment.
- Dangerous parts are physically protected: Install proper guarding to prevent access to moving or sharp parts.
- Inspections and maintenance are recorded Keep a clear audit trail for legal and safety purposes.
- Faulty equipment is taken out of use immediately No compromises: unsafe equipment should be isolated and repaired.



YOUR LEGAL DUTY: WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU'RE NOT PUWER COMPLIANT?

NON-COMPLIANCE

1. Legal Action & Fines

- Failure to comply can lead to HSE investigations
- Companies can face significant fines for breaches
- In serious cases, directors can be prosecuted

2. Injury or Fatality

- Unprotected machines are a major cause of workplace injuries
- You could be liable for employee injury claims and compensation

NON-COMPLIANCE

3. Business Disruption

- A single accident can shut down production
- HSE can issue prohibition notices halting operations

4. Reputational Damage

- Safety failures harm brand trust
- Loss of customer confidence and future contracts
